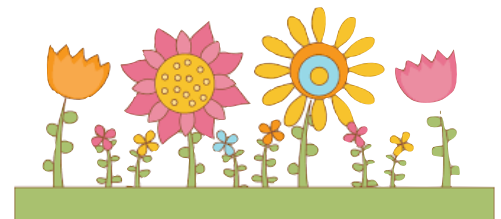
Ag Day - Friday 18 October (1st Friday Term 4)




In the holidays she took part in the NZ championship in New Plymouth, competing against 16 girls who had qualified in their areas throughout the country.
