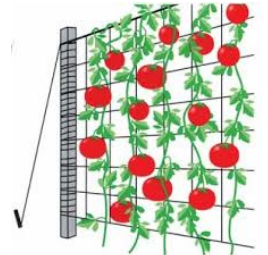


Garden to Table

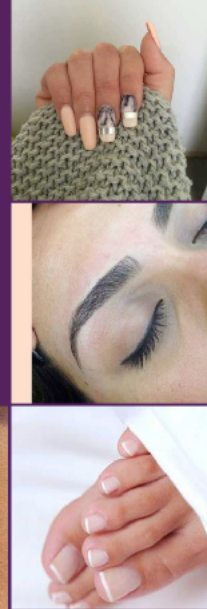
