Information leaflets for next year's Seasons for Growth Program will be sent home with children tomorrow.

Seasons for Growth is a grief and loss program which runs 3 to 4 times per year at Pahoia School. It is an 8 week peer support program for children between the ages of 6 and 12 who have experienced significant loss or change in their lives, due to death, separation/divorce, immigration or other events.

Seasons for Growth offers children a safe space to come together in small groups, and share their experiences. Participants learn that they are not alone in their experience of change, loss and grief. The program is led by trained facilitators and takes place on Tuesday afternoons for approximately one hour. The first sessions start on February 11, 2020.

Since its launch in 1996, over 300,000 children, young people and adults have participated in Seasons for Growth programs in Australia, New Zealand, Scotland, Ireland, England and Wales.
