Uniform Review

Based on community feedback in 2016 and 2018, we formed a committee involving teachers, students and parents, to review our school uniform. After thorough research, which included visits and contact with other schools, presentations from a variety of suppliers, sampling items and collecting student voice, the committee have selected an alternative uniform option for consultation with our school parents.

We also noticed that from these two surveys, support has grown for investigating a compulsory uniform. The school Board of Trustees would like to know the level of support within our school community for moving from an optional to compulsory uniform. Both uniforms will be on display in the office foyer until next Tuesday and at assembly this Friday.

Option 1 - New Uniform Option (Pictures Below) - Supplier: Kukri

- Emerald green polo with navy blue side panels
 - Navy blue shorts and skorts
 - Winter Option: Navy Fleece
- Prices (inc GST) Polo \$ 35, Shorts \$34, Skorts \$37, Fleece \$50, Bucket Hat \$21

Option 2 - Current Uniform - Supplier: New Zealand Uniforms
